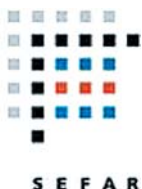

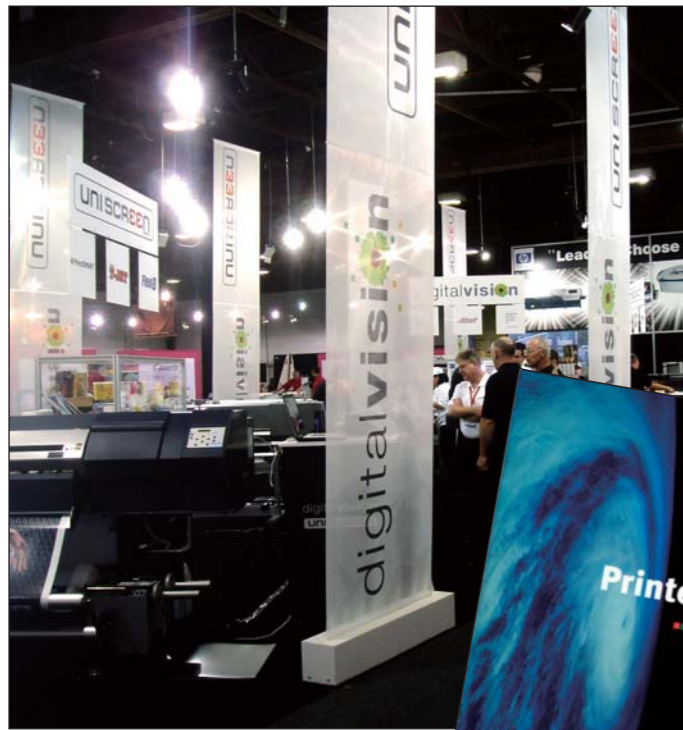

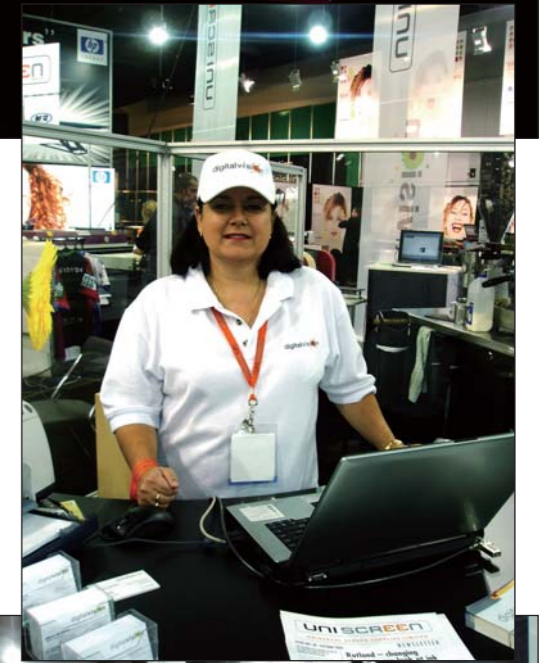

That approach, he says, reflects a change in thinking. "When digital was first introduced, many screenprinters felt threatened by it.
